
About us

Saga Kids is a global imprint of digital children's books. Our purpose is to inspire a lifelong love of reading from a very young age.




Janosch





was born on the 14th of November 1907 on the farm Näs outside Vimmerby, in the county of Småland, and died on the 28th January 2002 in her home on Dalagatan 46 in Stockholm. She wrote 34 chapter books and 41 picture books, which all together have sold a staggering 165 million copies!




Enid Blyton's books have sold over 500 million copies and have been translated into other languages more often than any other children's author. 




